1. House Keeping: Prem Bhandari

- Briefly reviewed the progress on book publication. The book project committee has made very good progress. Review process of the chapters is under way. There are 23 chapters in the book.
- Conference Proceedings Committee has compiled all the abstracts and making necessary arrangements for printing.
- By-laws: Some issues suggested by NAPA By-laws Review Committee will be presented at the AGM.

2. Updates from the President: Lila B. Karki

- Also highlighted some achievements: Agri-connection, NAPA talk sessions, Biennial
 conference, submissions of the conference, Book publication, NAPA Journal 'GJAAS',
 NAPA scholarships (~\$2500 collected), NAPA Endowment, Research and Policy Brief, etc.
- Presented the formation of Election Commission for the next term of Executive Committee.

3. Updates: Fund Raising for the Conference: Megha N. Parajulee

- As a Chair, of the Conference fund raising committee, he briefly updated the fund raising situation of the conference.
- Revisited the need of funds to award best paper/poster awards and to financially support to needy paper and poster presenters.
- Requested all EC members to donate for the conference and share the words in everybody's network.
- Sponsorship appeals will be shared with all as soon as possible.
- Election Commission. Presented the progress of the formation of the Election Commission for the election of Executive Officers for next term of the Executive Committee (2018-2020). Proposed Dr. Nanda P. Joshi, NAPA Adviser as the Chief of the Election Commission and also shared that he has graciously accepted the request to be the Chief Election Commissioner (CEC). The proposal was agreed unanimously.
- By consultation with the CEC, President, Vice President, and the General Secretary identified Dr. Ram Acharya from New Mexico and Dr. Buddhi Lamsal from Iowa as the Commissioners of the Election Commission on 03/20/2018.

4. Updates: Oklahoma Conference (OKC) 2018: Pradeep Wagle

- A total of 93 abstract submissions (papers and posters) from nine countries.
- Out of 93, 24 are poster submissions.
- 17 participants for student writing contest.
- Contact/lead persons have been identified from local committee members for several activities such as sports, cultural, door prizes, and logistics.
