#### Agenda:

### 1. Welcome to participants and initiation of the meeting by the President

- Welcomed the participants and wished happy new year.
- Thanked all NAPA EC members for continuous hard work for NAPA.
- General secretary thanked everybody for their support/contribution for NAPA on the occasion of NAPA's first anniversary (January 6).

#### 2. Updates from the President

- 2.1. Sameer Khanal's family incident support
- -The collected amount (\$1217 from 21 donors) has been sent to Mr. Khanal. NAPA received acknowledgement of support from Mr. Khanal.
- -President suggested to send a thank you letter to donors. Treasurer Ambika Tiwari and GS Prem Bhandari will work on this and send the message to donors.

#### 2.2 NAPA Talk Session

- -NAPA EC meeting thanked Dr. K P Paudel for delivering the second NAPA talk.
- -AFU Vice-chancellor and Secretary of Ministry of Agricultural development are interested to present in the forthcoming Talk Sessions. Similarly, HICAST Principal Dr. Binayak Rajbhandari is also interested to present. Scheduling will be made as per their availability.

#### 2.4. Nepal Travel

- -During recent trips of President and General Secretary to Nepal, there were NAPA meetings with several organizations/institutions and individuals, including AFU, HICAST, Agricultural Economics Society, Nepal Animal Sciences Association (NASA), Ministries of Agricultural and Livestock Development, NEMACOL, friends of agricultural federation and Veterinary Association and Campus of Live Sciences, Dang.
- -Friends from all sectors were interested and excited to work/collaborate with NAPA, mainly for technical expertise. They also expected continuity of NAPA's collaboration in the future.
- -Eight residents agriculturists (Dr. Vidur Ghimire, Mr. Agni P Nepal, Dr. Yogendra K Karki, Dr. Yam B. Thapa, Dr. Dilli B KC, Mr. Dibakar Paudyal, Dr. Rudra B Shrestha and Dr. Milan Adhikary) from Nepal joined NAPA. Ten more members have committed to join NAPA soon.
- -Membership fee (for Nepal based potential agriculturists and allied professionals): Drs. Karki and Bhandari have collected a flat amount of Rs 5,000.00 from each member as associate membership fee (this amount be more convenient for membership from Nepal). We, EC should consider fixing a lump sum amount of five thousand for associate members and granting life-long status of associate

membership. Many of the members and potential members cited examples of NRs one thousand to become life member of many professional associations in Nepal. EC should hold further discussion in this agenda.

#### 2.5 Other

- -NAPA EC should hold further discussion about NAPA membership from Nepal.
- -Dr. Raju Pandey (also a member of By-laws review committee) talked about possible revision of NAPA By-laws to add an EC member of NAPA from Nepal and also possibility of bringing student members from Nepal in NAPA. However, it might not be possible to bring a member in EC due to our current NAPA By-laws' working/focus area (only Northern and Southern America).
- Membership status, membership fee and member rights will be discussed further.
- -NAPA EC meeting discussed about the continuous absence of some EC members in the meeting without notice.
- -NAPA EC meeting also briefly discussed about Research/Policy Brief. Mr. GS will contact Dr. Bishow Adhikari and discuss about it. The first policy brief will be from Dr. Megha N Parajulee. For the second issue, Dr. Panthee will contribute.

#### 3. Brief updates on NAPA Activities

- 3.1NAPA Convention/Conference, 2018: was not discussed.
- -Conference Theme: NAPA will request to all NAPA members for the conference theme and finalize the theme as soon as possible.
- 3.2 Raju Pandey: Professional development of NAPA members proposal
- -Primary target group of NAPA professional development is NAPA members in Americas. He will consult with student co-ordination committee and identify their needs in terms of professional development.
- -Secondary target group is Agricultural professionals/students in Nepal.
